Bowling Green Elementary Schools (Grades K-5)

- Primary Talent Pool students (K-3) who are informally identified as high achieving and Project Challenge students (Gr. 4-5) who are formally identified as gifted meet once a week with a Gifted & Talented teacher for pull-out and/or collaborative services.
- Kentucky Virtual High School (KVHS) Pre-Algebra course offered for students who qualify.
- A variety of leadership, academic, and performing arts opportunities are offered.

Bowling Green Junior High School (Grades 6-8)

- Advanced math and science classes offered to those who meet entrance criteria.
- Three courses for high school credit offered at the middle school for those who qualify.
- Some students may travel to BGHS to take courses or participate in KVHS courses.
- 7th graders may take the ACT as part of the Duke Talent Identification Program (TIP).
- A variety of leadership, academic, and performing arts opportunities are offered.



Bowling Green High School (Grades 9-12)

- BGHS has one of the most successful Advanced Placement (AP) programs in the state.
- 17 AP courses are offered for possible college credit for any student who wishes to participate.
- Teachers provide support for students taking the PSAT, SAT, and ACT assessments.
- A variety of leadership, academic, and performing arts opportunities are offered.
